**FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT FOR INMATE HEALTH CARE  
SERVICES AT COOS COUNTY, OREGON  
(Effective November 1, 2017)**

This First Amendment (this "Amendment") to the Agreement for Inmate Health Care Services dated September 2, 2016 (the "Agreement"), is by and between and Coos County, Oregon, a political subdivision of the State of Oregon, acting by and through its Board of Commissioners (hereinafter, the "County") and Correct Care Solutions, LLC (hereinafter, "CCS"), a Kansas Limited Liability Company.

**WHEREAS**, Coos County is required to offer Hepatitis B vaccinations for its new hire Jail Staff and Coos County is required to provide Tuberculosis (TB) testing for all Jail Staff; and

**WHEREAS**, CCS Health Care Staff is equipped and qualified to administer Hepatitis B vaccinations, administer TB testing, and read TB test results; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parties agree that it is in the best interest of Jail Staff, CCS, and Covered Persons to amend the existing Agreement to provide for these additional services.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the mutual covenants herein contained and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the County and CCS agree:

1. **RECITALS.** The Parties hereto incorporate the foregoing recitals as a material portion of this Amendment.
2. **AMENDMENT TO DEFINITIONS.** The Agreement shall be amended by inserting the following definition:

**JAIL STAFF** – Current and/or prospective new hire Sheriff's Office deputies or other employees that currently work, or will be working, with Inmates or other County Inmate/Detainees at the Coos County Jail.

3. **AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE I: HEALTH CARE SERVICES.** The Agreement shall be amended by inserting the following language:


1.20 **JAIL STAFF VACCINATIONS AND TESTING.** CCS shall administer vaccinations for Jail Staff as requested by the County from time to time, including, but not necessarily limited to, Hepatitis Series B vaccinations. Additionally, CCS shall administer TB testing and read TB test results for Jail Staff as requested by the County from time to time. The County shall provide and bear the cost of all serum necessary to administer such vaccinations or testing. Jail Staff vaccinations and testing shall be arranged by the County at the convenience of CCS Health Care Staff.


4. **SEVERABILITY.** If any terms or provisions of this Amendment or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall to any extent be invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of this Amendment or the application of such term or provision to person or circumstances other than those as to which it is held invalid or unenforceable shall not be affected thereby and each term and provision of this Amendment shall be valid and enforceable to the fullest extent permitted by law.
5. **DEFINITIONS.** Capitalized terms used but not defined herein shall have the meaning ascribed to them under the Agreement.
6. **REMAINING PROVISIONS.** The remaining provisions of the Agreement not amended by this Amendment shall remain in full force and effect.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Parties have caused this Amendment to be executed in their names or their official acts by their respective representatives, each of whom is duly authorized to execute the same.


