Correctional Facility Disturbances Attachments

The GEO Group, Inc. (GEO) has gathered correctional facility disturbance information for those facilities operated by GEO in the United States since 1998 – meeting the definition of "criminal justice facility", i.e., a place of total confinement for convicted felons where no felon is allowed off the premises without the supervision of a sworn peace officer.
