11-19-13	<p>3 Patients' 1st tx in this unit; presented via WC &amp; is able to do his own transfer; consent signed &amp; this writer read the information. He appeared to understand however, 2nd hr. into tx, he became agitated &amp; states he "wants to go that way" pointing to the other end of unit; pulling on lines &amp; BP lines; an HCP was requested &amp; it was not pt. has "the [redacted]" &amp; "diarrhea" of [redacted] pt became more cooperative when tx was v. by 30" &amp; Ctl. was here; 1.0 kg removed &amp; left unit via WC; he does his own transfer - left in stable condition. <u>Ryan B.</u></p>
11/25/13	<p>pt arrived via ambulatory on a blanket or jacket made comfortable as possible confused &amp; needs freq. directions &amp; orientation; initial goal of 2.3 Kgs &amp; since pt had an episode where he became unresponsive tried by [redacted] placed in Trendelenburg position &amp; [redacted] given 2 pt results; TPC RN here &amp; BS was 229. Dr Satz 191-9250 then placed on Dr @ 2L via WC; unable to get BFR ↑ 255 due to frag. high arterial alarms; pt did have a large uric during the above episode &amp; this writer will remind IPC-staff prior to give a small meal prior to tx on Mon. 11/25/13; cath site cold &amp; dragging A per protocol; the remainder of the time on [redacted] went well; he does need several instructions &amp; direction; does follow the command for the most part; left unit via WC in stable condition; report called to TPC-RN <u>Ryan B.</u></p>
