At approximately 5:57AM, I/M Lape's health mainly due to his

Then main attending physician was Dr. Marvel.

Also present was I/M Lape's primary doctor and the ICU charge nurse. During this process the OIC was notified.

Orders were given to hospital security and to all hospital staff present that per OSCI, and State police guidelines that SMH ICU room 4027 with I/M Lape's in it was to be considered a crime scene and that no one but needed hospital staff is to be allowed into the room, this is to include no family members.

At that time Dr. Marvel and the charge nurse stated that they were going to allow the inmates family to come into the room since I/M Lape

I then reiterated that per the state police and OSCI guidelines it is now a crime scene until the state police released the body.

At approximately 6:51AM the call was made by Dr. Marvel and I/M Lape was pronounced dead. All unnecessary staff were released and left the room.

Shortly after Mrs. Ann Always, the hospital basically PR person for staff ignored my directives, the hospital security directives, and the crime scene protocols and brought the deceased's sister and fiancé back to the room. I again said that this was not to be allowed and Mrs. Always stated that it is their policy to let the family be present and touch the deceased in his or her passing. I informed again that this is not to happen, that it is a crime scene because he is a ward of the state. It was then that Dr. Marvel wheeled the bed that the deceased was on to the door entryway and stepped in between myself and the family and along with Mrs. Always allowed the family to enter further and touch the body contaminating the crime scene.

I voiced my distaste for their ignorance of police and state crime scene protocols in a professional manner and notified the OIC again and when the state police arrived informed them also.

During the course of this incident a crime scene log was started and continued until the state police released OSCI staff of the body. End of Report.
