#### Synopsis:

On 3/25/07 information was received by the IIU office at WCCW that offender had made allegations that CO Santos had sexually touched during her recovery from surgery at Harrison Hospital. This information came from other offenders her living unit and was written on incident reports by the duty officers. (See attached incident reports) Offender wrote a statement dated 3/25/07 (see attached). In this statement offender said that CO Santos had brought movies for her to watch and later awoke to find CO Santos standing over her with a hand on her shoulder telling her to cover up. At no time did she make any allegations in this statement of inappropriate touching by CO Santos. On 4/5/07 two WCCW officers were approached by an officer at the Kitsap county jail and stated that his niece was housed at WCCW and had told him that she had woken in the middle of the night to find an officer with his hand next to or on her vaginal area and thigh. (See attached statement by CO Grant). WCCW IIU interviewed offender again and notified HQ DOC SIU on 4/9/07 of a possible custodial sexual assault.

#### Narrative:

The following interviews were conducted during the course of the investigation:

Offender provided a written statement at WCCW on 03/25/2007 (see attached statement)

Offender stated that she was told by offender that CO Santos had been on hospital watch with her after the surgery and at some point after waking up from her anesthesia medications she remembered CO Santos telling her to get dressed. Later offender said that two other offenders approached her and said that offender was going to lie to fill in the unknown about when she woke up in the hospital and CO Santos was standing over her.

was interviewed at WCCW on 04/06/2007 by WCCW Offender III I Investigator Henry Keller (see attached email dated 04/09/2007)

Offender in this interview stated that she did not remember CO Santos touching her but felt by the way that he acted after the incident that something must have happened. Offender stated that CO Santos was so nice before but was quiet and did not talk to her afterwards.

Investigative Note: Offender was interviewed by Investigator Baxter of HO DOC/SIU on 04/13/2007. Also present was Investigator Kelly of WCCW IIU and Christina Abby WCCW Health Care Manager. During this interview offender again stated that at no time did CO Santos have his hand near her groin but may have bumped up against her leg as she woke up. Offender also stated that the only reason that she felt something had happened was due to the fact that CO Santos acted different to her before and after she woke up from surgery.

Summary: Based on information that has been received and individuals interviewed. there is insufficient evidence to show that any custodial misconduct occurred between offender and CO Santos.

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



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

On April 06, 2007 I spoke with Offender described by the below concerns. Offender that the officer in question brought 10-12 movies (CDs) to the hospital with him and laid them out on the bed allowing her to choose the titles that she wished to view stated that due to the pain medications that she was on and "coming out of anesthesia" and "lack of present mind" she did not have a preference in the titles and the same also added that that she saw this particular officer sleeping on several occasions throughout his shift.

Offender stated that she thought it was strange that the officer in question choose to position his chair directly next to her, and the other officers would place their chair, either across the room from her or next to the room entrance. She added that Officer Easton was the officer on shift just prior to the subject officer on the date of the alleged occurrence.

I asked Offender the state of the events that have lead to these accusations. Offender stated that she awoke to her knees moving, the state of the she never saw the officer's hands in the area of her knees, it was merely the sensation of her leg/knees being moved that awoke her.) she stated that she opened her eves to find the officer in question leaning over her while her sheets was pushed to the foot of the bed. The stated that she began thrashing "in the motion of doing the backstroke while swimming."

stated, at that time the officer in question used his hand to push her against the bed and was telling her to calm down and cover back up (under her sheet/blanket). \_\_\_\_\_\_\_added that she thought this reaction was due to all the noise that had been made by her reaction and he (officer) was concerned about a nurse "or someone" coming in. Offender stated, when she was thrashing about, she "banged" her food tray that "made all sorts of noise" and "some of the alarms from all those monitors they hook you up to went off."

Offender detailed that she is positive the officer in question attempted to "do something to her that evening" because he was so nice at the beginning of the shift and after "the incident" he did not speak to her anymore and "did not even say goodbye at the end of his shift, like the rest of the officers did." added that the subject officer acts different to her back at the facility as well, "he won't make eye contact with me and tries to avoid me."

Lasked Offender when she reported this issue to the control of the stated that she had not had the opportunity to tell her uncle yet, her father was the only person in the family that she told and that was, "a few days ago during visit." (WCCW received a report on 04/06/07 indicating County Corrections Officer) had spoken, first hand, with his niece regarding the details of the allegations)

I asked Offender now long, approximately, it took for a nurse to respond to her room when she was thrashing about and "some of the alarms from all those monitors they hook you up to went off." Offender stated, "Oh, no alarms went off or anything."

At the conclusion of my questioning, LPN Clarecce Nash attempted to discuss with Offender some of the reactions the human body may experience post surgery, as anesthesia exits it's systems. LPN Nash stated hallucinations, strange sensations throughout the body, confusion and flashbacks are not uncommon when a 0 1 4 person is recovering from the administration of anesthesia. Offender continued to insist that the officer in question had done something to her and is sure if he had ever conducted hospital watch prior to her.

On April 06, 2007 I spoke with Offender street of the property 
laims that she and continued to discuss the issue and whether it should be reported or not. It is allegedly began to doubt her original recall of events due to the medications that she was on, however she allegedly indicated to that she "certainly would not be against filling in the blanks." I informed Offender that I was aware that she has already provided a statement to Sgt. Byassee surrounding this incident, however I would like her to complete another statement providing Offender statements in detail. Offender assured me that a statement would be the IIU distro-box by Monday April 09, 2007.

On April 07, and 08, 2007 I attempted to contact Mister (who is the first party) reported these accusation to. The contact number (Nextel cell phone) provided by Officer (of Kitsap County Corrections was out of service according to the message received when called.

Alice WCCW began an invesetigation into this matter on 3-25th. This attached description is markedly differnent than what the offender told the Sgt. or what she wrote to tall. The offender told the SGT. That while in the hopsiltal CO Santos was standing over her with his hand on her shoulder telling her to cover up. The offender was just coming off of medication following her surgery. She was thrushing her arms and CO Santos told her to be still and cover herself up. The offender told the Sgt. I think he may have been doing something but got caught because he would not talk to or look at her the rest of the night. Offender said Santos was not friendly like the other officers and treated her like an inmate. The offender alos indicated in the written statement to tall that an officer (not named) brought 10-12 videos into the hospial. Christina Abby was also notified, she contact Bremeton Hospital and the doctor checked with the nursing staff and hosiptal records and there was no indication of anything reported by the nursing staff or the offender during her stay. The incident was reported by a unit offender who also told staff the allleged victim told the reproting offender she was making it up. I contacted HO DO Mike Kenny and read him parts of the attachements and the prior investigative efforts. We agreed on the following plan. Tall Keller will meet with the offender and medical tonight. CO Santos will be allowed to work in the MI only as the offender is in L unit.
