Synopsis:

On 3/25/07 information was received by the IIU office at WCCW that offender [REDACTED] had made allegations that CO Santos had sexually touched during her recovery from surgery at Harrison Hospital. This information came from other offenders her living unit and was written on incident reports by the duty officers. (See attached incident reports) Offender [REDACTED] wrote a statement dated 3/25/07 (see attached). In this statement offender [REDACTED] said that CO Santos had brought movies for her to watch and later awoke to find CO Santos standing over her with a hand on her shoulder telling her to cover up. At no time did she make any allegations in this statement of inappropriate touching by CO Santos. On 4/5/07 two WCCW officers were approached by an officer at the Kitsap county jail and stated that his niece [REDACTED] was housed at WCCW and had told him that she had woken in the middle of the night to find an officer with his hand next to or on her vaginal area and thigh. (See attached statement by CO Grant). WCCW IIU interviewed offender [REDACTED] again and notified HQ DOC SIU on 4/9/07 of a possible custodial sexual assault.

Narrative:

The following interviews were conducted during the course of the investigation:

Offender [REDACTED] provided a written statement at WCCW on 03/25/2007 (see attached statement)

In this written statement offender [REDACTED] states that offender [REDACTED] had conversations with her and other offenders to the fact that she thought that perhaps a certain officer, name unknown had attempted to touch her while she was medicated from her surgery. Offender [REDACTED] did not believe it happened; rather it was a result from the medications and mental strain from problems with her husband.

Offender [REDACTED] provided a written statement at WCCW on 03/25/2007 (see attached statement)

Offender [REDACTED] stated that she was told by offender [REDACTED] that CO Santos had been on hospital watch with her after the surgery and at some point after waking up from her anesthesia medications she remembered CO Santos telling her to get dressed. Later offender [REDACTED] said that two other offenders approached her and said that offender [REDACTED] was going to lie to fill in the unknown about when she woke up in the hospital and CO Santos was standing over her.

Offender [REDACTED] was interviewed at WCCW on 04/06/2007 by WCCW IIU Investigator Henry Keller (see attached email dated 04/09/2007)

Offender [REDACTED] in this interview stated that she did not remember CO Santos touching her but felt by the way that he acted after the incident that something must have happened. Offender [REDACTED] stated that CO Santos was so nice before but was quiet and did not talk to her afterwards.

**Investigative Note:** Offender [REDACTED] was interviewed by Investigator Baxter of HQ DOC/SIU on 04/13/2007. Also present was Investigator Kelly of WCCW IIU and Christina Abby WCCW Health Care Manager. During this interview offender [REDACTED] again stated that at no time did CO Santos have his hand near her groin but may have bumped up against her leg as she woke up. Offender [REDACTED] also stated that the only reason that she felt something had happened was due to the fact that CO Santos acted different to her before and after she woke up from surgery.

**Summary:** Based on information that has been received and individuals interviewed, there is insufficient evidence to show that any custodial misconduct occurred between offender [REDACTED] and CO Santos.



Offender [REDACTED] had made some comments in regards to possible inappropriate sexual conduct by Officer Santos while she was in the hospital for surgery. I spoke with the offender on 03.25.07 at 1906 in my office. I asked her to tell me what had happened. She said that while she was in the hospital C/O Santos was the officer staying with her. He had brought in 10 or 12 DVD's to watch. The other officers that had been there before sat across the room, but he sat in the chair right next to her. She said that she was drifting in and out of consciousness because of the medication. She was wearing the hospital gown that was open in the back and had her legs in "those stocking like things that massage your legs so that you don't get blood clots." At one time I woke up and he was standing over me with his hand on my shoulder telling me to cover up. I was thrashing my arms and he told me to be still and cover up. I think he may have been doing something and then got caught because he wouldn't talk to me the rest of the night and won't look at me. He wasn't acting like a friend like the other officers. The other officers treated me like a person and not an inmate. After listening to Offender [REDACTED] I requested that she write a statement in her own words. She complied.

Interviewed the offender, notified Lt. Ahmu, had offender write statement, attached to the incident report, instructed the offender not to discuss this with any offenders.

He said he had just spoken with Offender [REDACTED] and she had said that offender [REDACTED] was telling people the Officer Santos had been sexually inappropriate with her while she was in the hospital. He gave me an incident report. I went to L-Unit and spoke with Officer Santos, and had him write an incident report. At 1845, I interviewed Offender [REDACTED] in K-Unit Sergeant's Office. She said that Offender [REDACTED] had made the comments and had been telling other offenders about it. And that she [REDACTED] didn't believe it to be completely true. I requested her to write a statement as to what she had been told or had heard. She complied. The statement is attached.

Investigative Complaint

On 04/05/07, at 1230 hrs, CCO Miller and I were at the Kitsap County Jail when we were contacted by Officer [REDACTED] who was on duty. [REDACTED] asked to speak to me in private about a personal matter.

[REDACTED] stated his niece [REDACTED] is an inmate at the Washington State Corrections Center for Women in Purdy. She is serving a sentence for trafficking methamphetamine. [REDACTED] stated he talked with his niece approximately a week or so ago.

[REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] told him she was taken to a hospital located in Bremerton in mid March for surgery which required an over night stay. She was escorted by a Corrections Officer from the facility. Sometime in the middle of the night [REDACTED] woke up to find the Corrections Officer standing next to her bed with his hand "next to or on her vaginal area and thigh". She asked the officer what he was doing and he replied something to the effect he was covering her with a blanket because it fell off her.

[REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] told him when she returned to Purdy she told her cellmates about the incident and that she was going to turn the officer in. [REDACTED] was threatened with physical violence by the cellmates and the cellmates said the officer was "their hole in the fence" indicating the Officer "gets them things".

[REDACTED] told me he was unsure who he could trust to report the incident. I told [REDACTED] I would bring the matter to the attention of my supervisor.

[REDACTED] said [REDACTED] described the Officer as possibly a Filipino male with the last name of "Shaudo" or "Sudo".

[REDACTED] asked to be contacted by the appropriate Department of Corrections authority. He provided his home phone number: (360) 830-5438. The best time to reach him is after 6 PM.

On April 06, 2007 I spoke with Offender [REDACTED] regarding the below concerns. Offender [REDACTED] stated that the officer in question brought 10-12 movies (CDs) to the hospital with him and laid them out on the bed allowing her to choose the titles that she wished to view. [REDACTED] stated that due to the pain medications that she was on and "coming out of anesthesia" and "lack of present mind" she did not have a preference in the titles. [REDACTED] also added that that she saw this particular officer sleeping on several occasions throughout his shift.

Offender [REDACTED] stated that she thought it was strange that the officer in question choose to position his chair directly next to her, and the other officers would place their chair, either across the room from her or next to the room entrance. She added that Officer Easton was the officer on shift just prior to the subject officer on the date of the alleged occurrence.

I asked Offender [REDACTED] to recall the events that have lead to these accusations. Offender [REDACTED] stated that she awoke to her knees moving. ([REDACTED] interjected the she never saw the officer's hands in the area of her knees, it was merely the sensation of her leg/knees being moved that awoke her.) she stated that she opened her eyes to find the officer in question leaning over her while her sheets was pushed to the foot of the bed. [REDACTED] stated that she began thrashing "in the motion of doing the backstroke while swimming."

[REDACTED] stated, at that time the officer in question used his hand to push her against the bed and was telling her to calm down and cover back up (under her sheet/blanket). [REDACTED] added that she thought this reaction was due to all the noise that had been made by her reaction and he (officer) was concerned about a nurse "or someone" coming in. Offender [REDACTED] stated, when she was thrashing about, she "banged" her food tray that "made all sorts of noise" and "some of the alarms from all those monitors they hook you up to went off."

Offender [REDACTED] stated that she is positive the officer in question attempted to "do something to her that evening" because he was so nice at the beginning of the shift and after "the incident" he did not speak to her anymore and "did not even say goodbye at the end of his shift, like the rest of the officers did." [REDACTED] added that the subject officer acts different to her back at the facility as well, "he won't make eye contact with me and tries to avoid me."

I asked Offender [REDACTED] when she reported this issue to [REDACTED]. Offender [REDACTED] stated that she had not had the opportunity to tell her uncle yet, her father was the only person in the family that she told and that was, "a few days ago during visit." (WCCW received a report on 04/06/07 indicating [REDACTED] (Kitsap County Corrections Officer) had spoken, first hand, with his niece [REDACTED] regarding the details of the allegations)

I asked Offender [REDACTED] how long, approximately, it took for a nurse to respond to her room when she was thrashing about and "some of the alarms from all those monitors they hook you up to went off." Offender [REDACTED] stated, "Oh, no alarms went off or anything."

At the conclusion of my questioning, LPN Clareece Nash attempted to discuss with Offender [REDACTED] some of the reactions the human body may experience post surgery, as anesthesia exits it's systems. LPN Nash stated hallucinations, strange sensations throughout the body, confusion and flashbacks are not uncommon when a person is recovering from the administration of anesthesia. Offender [REDACTED] continued to insist that the officer in question had done something to her and is sure if he had ever conducted hospital watch prior to her,

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then it has happened before.

On April 06, 2007 I spoke with Offender [REDACTED] regarding her supplemental information surrounding this issue. Offender [REDACTED] stated that immediately upon returning from the hospital, Offender [REDACTED] began talking to her about an officer violating her while she was unconscious at the hospital. Offender [REDACTED] claimed that she used to be an Operating Room Nurse prior to her incarceration and explained to [REDACTED] the side effects of anesthesia, [REDACTED] allegedly informed [REDACTED] that it may have been a hallucination or a flashback from her past. ([REDACTED] claims that she has first hand knowledge that [REDACTED] was violated by a family member at a young age.)

[REDACTED] claims that she and [REDACTED] continued to discuss the issue and whether it should be reported or not. [REDACTED] allegedly began to doubt her original recall of events due to the medications that she was on, however she allegedly indicated to [REDACTED] that she "certainly would not be against filling in the blanks." I informed Offender [REDACTED] that I was aware that she has already provided a statement to Sgt. Byassee surrounding this incident, however I would like her to complete another statement providing Offender [REDACTED] statements in detail. Offender [REDACTED] assured me that a statement would be the IIU distro-box by Monday April 09, 2007.

On April 07, and 08, 2007 I attempted to contact Mister [REDACTED], who is [REDACTED] father and is allegedly the first party [REDACTED] reported these accusation to. The contact number (Nextel cell phone) provided by Officer [REDACTED] of Kitsap County Corrections was out of service according to the message received when called.

On Monday April 09, 2007, with authorization to do so; [REDACTED] will be contacted at his home, once that contact number can be established. Mr. [REDACTED] will be contacted to cooperate or refute that the statement "whole in the fence." was made by Offender [REDACTED], when referring to the subject officer as she spoke of these allegations to her father.

Alice WCCW began an investigation into this matter on 3-25th. This attached description is markedly different than what the offender told the Sgt. or what she wrote to I&I. The offender told the SGT. That while in the hospital CO Santos was standing over her with his hand on her shoulder telling her to cover up. The offender was just coming off of medication following her surgery. She was thrashing her arms and CO Santos told her to be still and cover herself up. The offender told the Sgt. I think he may have been doing something but got caught because he would not talk to or look at her the rest of the night. Offender said Santos was not friendly like the other officers and treated her like an inmate. The offender also indicated in the written statement to I&I that an officer (not named) brought 10-12 videos into the hospital. Christina Abby was also notified, she contacted Bremerton Hospital and the doctor checked with the nursing staff and hospital records and there was no indication of anything reported by the nursing staff or the offender during her stay. The incident was reported by a unit offender who also told staff the alleged victim told the reporting offender she was making it up. I contacted HQ DO Mike Kenny and read him parts of the attachments and the prior investigative efforts. We agreed on the following plan. I&I Keller will meet with the offender and medical tonight. CO Santos will be allowed to work in the MI only as the offender is in L unit.

Additional information...CO Santos has been employed at WCCW since before 1996 9 I&I Keller's recall). There are no prior allegations of this type against him. -----Original Message-----

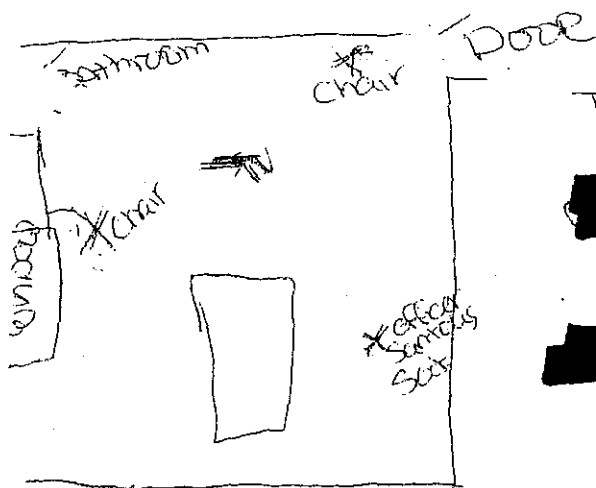
